

## USA HOCKEY WRITTEN TRANSFERS

### Letter of Approval

Per International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF) transfer regulations non-citizen players, men or women, under 18 years of age may be transferred by means of a letter of approval.\* This form is to be used for European and Canadian minor age players playing hockey on Youth & Girls classification teams. Most written transfers are processed for one season only. There is no fee to process a written transfer.

Players should also provide proof of legal residency in the United States to their team. This information should be kept with the team registration materials.

**After completing Part A, fax or mail the form to the USA Hockey National Office.** Once the transfer is approved a copy will be sent to the new team and/or District Registrar for that area.
